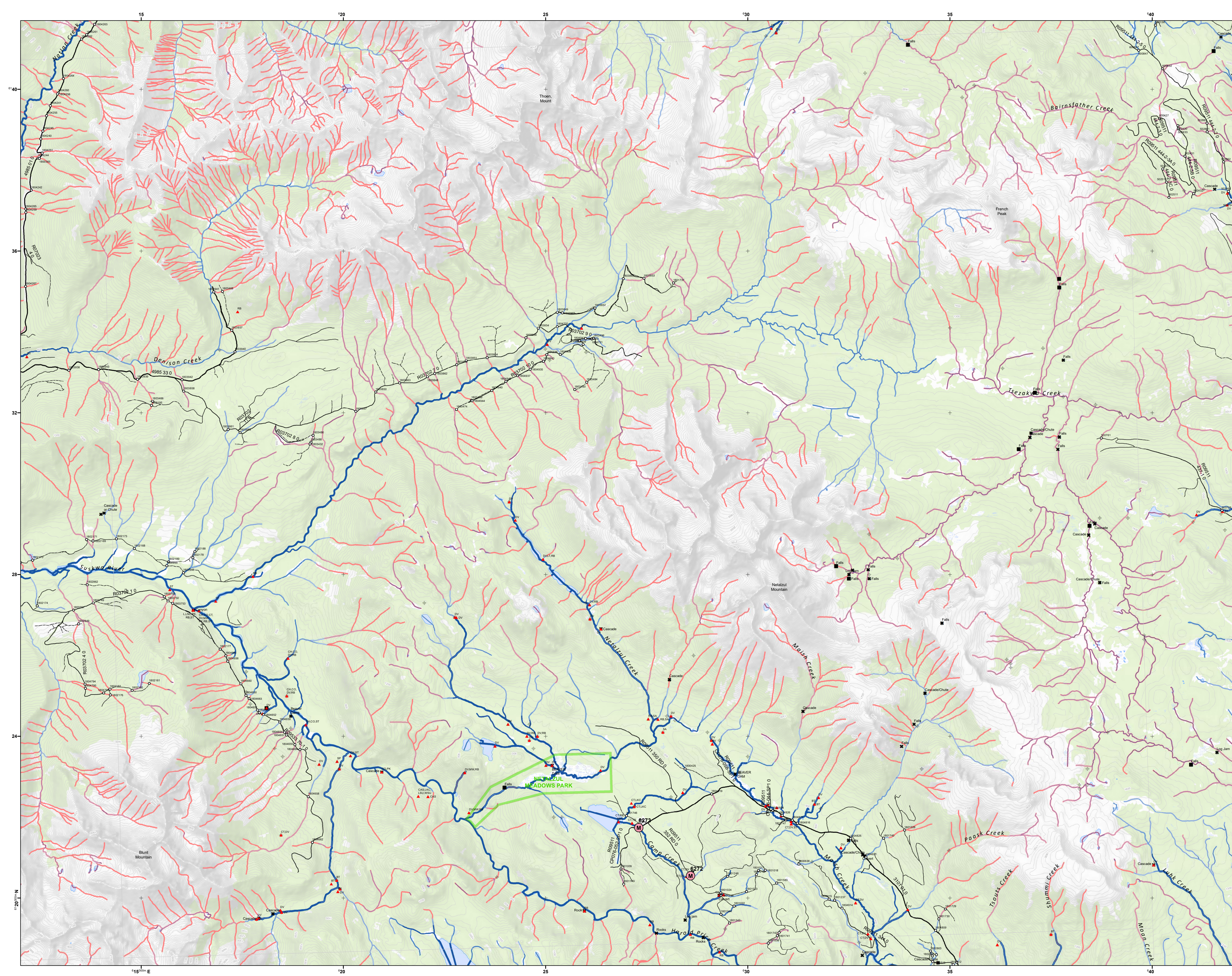




Fish Passage Site Prioritization

Modelled Potential Fish Habitat

- Observed fish habitat
- Inferred fish habitat - no stream >5% for >100m
- Inferred fish habitat - no stream >13% for >100m
- Inferred fish habitat - no stream >20% for >100m
- Non fish habitat

Average stream gradient

- 0 - 5% - riffle and cascade pool
- 6 - 13% - step pool
- 14 - 20% - step pool, very steep
- Non fish habitat

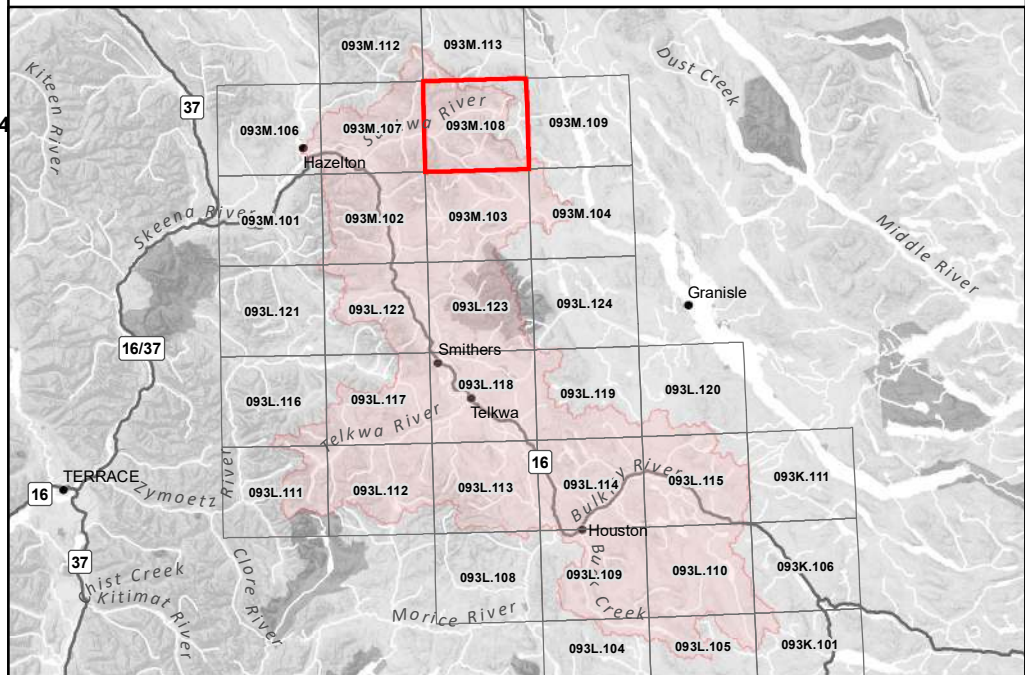
